

Public drop-in: changes to Dove Cliff Weir

The Environment Agency will be holding a public drop-in event to update the local community on changes to Dove Cliff weir.

The Environment Agency is working to restore the River Dove to improve biodiversity and improve fish passage from the River Trent, through the entire Dove catchment - by removing the first obstacle to fish migration on the River Dove.

Removing the Dove Cliff Weir will open up over 30 miles of migratory habitat for fish and other species.
