### **Parish Councillors**

The remaining vacancy on the Parish Council was filled at the March meeting when Councillors welcomed Vivien Sharples as a co-opted councillor.

### **Andy Starbuck memorial seat**

The family are extremely happy with the seat which has been installed on The Croft and they thanked all those individuals and organisations in the village that had contributed to the seat.

### **Queen's Platinum Jubilee**

The Parish Council decided at its March meeting to purchase a Queen's Platinum Jubilee Commemoration bench seat, complete with commemorative plaque at a cost of £1,527 including installation.

### Free compost bins for residents

The Parish Council successfully applied to the Staffordshire County Council's Climate Change Action Fund for £500 to purchase 32 No. compost bins.

The compost bins have a capacity of 330 litres and measure 800mm diameter and 1000mm height.



The compost bins will be distributed free of charge to applicants who reside in the village. Applications will not be accepted from anyone living outside the village; Parish Councillors have agreed that they will not apply for a bin.

The County Council's website encourages people to home compost, saying:

*Composting has countless benefits, and spring is the perfect time to get started. The process simply involves recycling people's daily plant and food waste, along with any other organic materials. This can include grass cuttings, unwanted plants, organic kitchen waste such as fruit and vegetable peelings, tea bags, coffee grounds and even the vacuum contents.*

*Together, these will naturally decompose over time in these specialised compost bins to produce a ready-made mixture rich in nutrients to feed soil and nourish gardens.*

If you would like a free compost bin, simply complete the application form and return this to the Parish Clerk by Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2022. Arrangements for distributing the bins will be notified to successful applicants as soon as possible after the closing date.
